THE UTILITY APPAREL (MAXIMUM PRICES AND CHARGES) (BALLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

Maximum Prices.

1. The maximum prices to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer in respect of utility goods, being utility apparel (in this Order referred to as "goods") shall be -
  - (1) in the case of goods of a specification number specified in Column 1 of the First Schedule hereto, the appropriate amount specified in Column 2 thereof with the addition of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent of such amount;
  - (2) in any other case the aggregate of the following amounts:-
    - (a) the price paid or agreed to be paid to the manufacturer or wholesaler, by the first purchaser, being a retailer; and
    - (b) an amount equal to the appropriate percentage of such price specified in Column 2 of the Second Schedule; and
    - (c) an amount equal to  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent of the aggregate of the foregoing amounts;

so, however, that in respect of goods of the descriptions specified in Column 1 of the appropriate Part of the relevant Related Schedule, the maximum price computed in accordance with paragraph (2) of this Article shall not exceed the appropriate amount specified in Column 3 of such Schedule, with the addition of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent of such amount.

Variations of Over-Riding Maxima.

2. The variations of over-riding maxima specified in the appropriate Parts of the relevant Related Schedule shall have effect as therein respectively provided.

Rounding Provisions.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order -

On a sale by a retailer of goods -

- (a) the maximum price of which, computed in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order, does not exceed the sum of 5s., the maximum price shall be rounded to the nearest halfpenny;
- (b) the maximum price of which, computed as aforesaid exceeds the sum of 5s., the maximum price shall be rounded to the nearest penny;

Provided that in respect of goods of the description specified in Column 1 of the relevant Related Schedule, the maximum price, when rounded, shall in no case exceed the amount specified in Column 3 of such Related Schedule with the addition of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  per cent of such amount.

Maximum Charges for Alteration Services.

4. (1) The maximum charge to be made in the course of the business of a retailer who performs the service of carrying out or contracting to carry out alterations to a garment, being goods sold by him, within a period of three months from the date of the sale thereof, shall be -
- (i) in respect of a garment (not being a made-to-measure garment or a garment made wholly of fur skin):-
    - (a) the actual cost to the retailer of such alterations, or
    - (b) the sum of 15s.whichever shall be the less.
  - (ii) in respect of a garment made wholly or mainly of fur skin (not being a made-to-measure garment):-
    - (a) the actual cost to the retailer of such alterations, or
    - (b) the sum of £1.whichever shall be the less.
  - (iii) in respect of a made-to-measure garment, whether or not made wholly or mainly of fur skin, the sum of 1d.
- (2) All alterations to which this Article applies shall be separately charged.
- (3) In this Article "a garment" means, in relation to a garment comprising two or more articles, all such articles.

Interpretation and Revocation.

5. (1) In this Order -
- (i) "A Related Schedule" means a Related Schedule (including any Supplement thereto) issued by the Board of Trade for the purposes of The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) Order, 1949, and mentioned in the Third Schedule hereto;
  - (ii) "The Board of Trade" means the Board of Trade of the United Kingdom;
  - (iii) "goods" means goods to which this Order applies but does not include second-hand goods;
  - (iv) "maximum price" means the price, from which the cost actually paid or incurred in delivering the goods may be excluded, payable before any deduction by way of discount;
  - (v) "purchase price" means the price inclusive of all delivery charges payable after all deductions by way of discount other than cash or settlement discounts not exceeding 5 per cent;
  - (vi) "utility goods" has the meaning assigned in The Apparel and Textiles (Guernsey) Order, 1945;
  - (vii) "wholesaler" includes a manufacturer in respect of the sale of goods not of his own manufacture.

- (2) A number set out in Column 1 (b) of the First Schedule hereto, or in any Related Schedule in a column headed "specification number of cloth" or "specification number of garment" refers to cloth or a garment (as the case may be) being utility goods described in relation to that number in any Schedule to any Order made by the Board of Trade.
- (3) Any reference in any Related Schedule to a specification number shall be deemed to include a reference to that number preceded by the letter "Z".
- (4) References in this Order to any other Order shall be construed as references to that Order, as amended by any subsequent Order, or to any other Order revoking and re-enacting that Order with or without further amendment.
- (5) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
- (6) The Orders specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.

Citation and Commencement.

6. This Order may be cited as The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 21st day of November, 1950.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order consolidates the Orders amending The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, which fixes retailers' maximum prices for utility apparel. It also brings into force Supplements Nos. 2 and 3 to Related Schedule No. 1J, Supplement No. 3 to Related Schedule No. 4J, Supplement No. 1 to Related Schedule No. 5G and Supplement No. 2 to Related Schedule No. 17 and substitutes Related Schedule No. 16A for Related Schedule No. 16 and Supplements Nos. 1 and 2 thereto. The Related Schedules and the Supplements thereto provide retailers' over-riding maximum prices for the goods to which they relate.
