IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY)
ORDER, 1949, AMENDMENT NO. 7 ORDER, 1950.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. There shall be deleted from the First Schedule of the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, (a), the following item:-

"Poultry, live".

2. There shall be deleted from the fourth paragraph of the Delegation of Power to grant Import Licences (No. 1) Order, 1949, (b), the following words:-

"Live Poultry and"

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of December, 1950, and may be cited as the "Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment No. 7 Order, 1950".

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

The effect of the above Order, in conjunction with an Ordinance entitled "The Live Poultry Importation Ordinance, 1950", is that, as from 1st December, 1950 -

- (1) Live poultry imported from Jersey or any of the Islands of this Bailiwick will need no licence.
- (2) Live poultry imported from the United Kingdom, or the Isle of Man will require a licence from the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries.
- (3) Live poultry from anywhere other than the places mentioned in (1) and (2) above will need an additional licence issued by the Board of Administration.
