IMPORT & EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.

The Importation of Pigs (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

- (1) The importation of pigs into Guernsey is prohibited save under and in accordance with the terms of a licence granted in that behalf by the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries.
- (2) This Order shall come into force on the 7th June, 1949, and may be cited as "The Importation of Pigs (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949."

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

The effect of the above Order is that pigs may only be imported into Guernsey under licence issued by the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries. This Order is additional to other requirements of the Law for the time being in force relating to the importation of pigs.
