IMPORT & EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946.

THE IMPORTATION OF POULTRY (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949.

The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the Import & Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The importation into Guernsey of poultry from Sark, whether dead or alive, is prohibited.
2. This Order shall come into force on the 10th day of June, 1949, and may be cited as "The Importation of Poultry (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949".

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

The effect of the above Order is to prohibit the importation of Poultry, whether dead or alive, into Guernsey from Sark. The issue of the Order has been necessary by reason of a confirmed outbreak of Fowl Pest in Sark.
