THE MILK (CONTROL AND RATIONING (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1947,
AMENDMENT NO. 5 ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, the President of the States' Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities and the States Dairy Committee hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Milk (Control and Rationing) (Guernsey) Order, 1947, as amended, shall be further amended by substituting for Article 4 thereof, the following Article:-

"4. (1) The owner of cattle may, notwithstanding any provision of this Order to the contrary, retain milk for household consumption in his household and one pint for each farm hand employed by him in the tending of his cattle.

(2) This Article shall apply only to those owners of cattle whose cattle are habitually pastured and stabled on premises in the occupation of and farmed by such owner.

(3) (a) Where the ownership of any cattle vests in more than one person and those persons do not reside altogether in the same house, none of those persons shall be entitled to retain any whole milk for household consumption in his household or for his farm hands as provided in paragraph (1) of this Article unless the name and address of one of those persons nominated by all of them as the person to be so entitled has been registered with the Dairy Committee whereupon the person whose name and address has been so registered shall be deemed for the purpose of these paragraphs to be the sole owner of those cattle and shall be entitled to retain milk for household consumption in his household and for his farm hands in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) of this Article.

(b) For the purposes of sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph where the ownership of cattle vests in a limited liability Company, the shareholders of the Company shall be deemed to be the owners of the cattle.

(4) No person receiving an allowance of milk under the provisions of this Article shall obtain milk from any retailer."

2. This Order may be cited as The Milk (Control and Rationing) (Guernsey) Order, 1947, Amendment No. 5 Order, 1949, and shall come into force on the 4th day of June, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order permits an owner of cattle to retain whatever milk is required for household consumption in his household and one pint for each farm hand employed by him in the tending of his cattle. Where the ownership is vested in a partnership or a limited liability Company, the partners or the shareholders, as the case may be, are required to register with the States Dairy Committee one of the partners or a shareholder who, for the purposes of this Order, shall be deemed to be the owner of the cattle.
