## STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

EXPORT OF TOMATOES.

1949 No. 8

CHANGE OF ZONES.

The States Committee for Horticulture, in pursuance of paragraph 10 of the Report of Tomatoes (1949) No. 2 Order, hereby directs: -

1. The change of zones as regards permitted shipping days will take place during the week ending June 25th, 1949.
2. During the week ending June 25th, tomatoes packed in the Northern and Southern Zones will be shipped as follows: -

Monday, June 20th. Northern Zone will ship.

Tuesday, June 21st. Southern Zone will ship.

Wednesday, June 22nd. Northern Zone will ship.

Thursday, June 23rd. Tomatoes packed in either of the two zones may be shipped.

Friday, June 24th. Southern Zone will ship.

Saturday, June 25th. Northern Zone will ship.

3. The shipping days for the Zones from Friday, June 24th, until further notice are therefore as follows: -

Northern Zone - Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Saturdays.

Southern Zone - Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.
