THE PRESERVES (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Preserves (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, shall be amended as follows:-
- (a) by deleting from Article 2 thereof the words "or Second";
 - (b) by substituting in the said Article 2 for the word "Schedules" the word "Schedule"; and
 - (c) by deleting the Second Schedule thereto.
2. This Order may be cited as The Preserves (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 27th day of June, 1949.
