THE IMPORTATION OF POULTRY (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER 1949.

AMENDMENT ORDER 1949.

1. The Board of Administration, in pursuance of the "Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946", hereby revokes the Importation of Poultry (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated 9th June, 1949. *-S.T.N.B.S.*
2. This Order shall come into force on the 13th July, 1949, and may be cited as the "Importation of Poultry (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, Amendment Order 1949".

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

The effect of the above Order is that the prohibition imposed on the importation of poultry, dead or alive, from Sark is now removed. Would-be importers are, however, reminded that the importation of live poultry is only permissible under licence issued by the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries.
