THE BREAD (CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Bread (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1948, as amended, shall be further amended by substituting for the Second Schedule thereto the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as The Bread (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1949.

THE SCHEDULE.

Maximum Prices of Bread.

1. (Note:- These prices do not apply in the cases specified in Article 12 of the Order).

<u>Column 1.</u>	<u>Column 2.</u>
<u>Description of Sale.</u>	<u>Maximum Price.</u>
(a) in the case of a 14 oz. loaf.	2½d. per loaf.
(b) in any other case.	at the rate of 2½d. per 14 oz.

2. No additional charge in respect of transport or delivery shall be made or demanded by the seller on or in connection with any sale of bread by retail.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order reduces the maximum retail prices of bread in Alderney to 2½d. in the case of a 14 oz. loaf and at the rate of 2½d. per 14 oz. in any other case.
