THE FATS, CHEESE AND TEA (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1949.

REVOKED - See S. I. 100 of 1950.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

NOT RECEIVED

1. The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, shall be amended as follows:-
 - (a) by substituting in sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of paragraph (1) Article 8 thereof for the words "an amount calculated at the rate of 9/28ths oz. in total (but so that not more than 3/28ths oz. shall be butter and not more than 1/14th oz. shall be cooking fats)" the words "an amount calculated at the rate of 5/14ths oz. in total (but so that not more than 1/7th oz. shall be butter and not more than 1/14th oz. shall be cooking fats)";
 - (b) by substituting in the Schedule thereto, which specifies the amount of the ration, for the entries relating to butter, margarine and cooking fats the entries in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 17th day of July, 1949.
