THE IMPORTED APPLES AND PEARS (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLWICK OF GUERNSEY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Imported Apples and Pears ¹²⁷¹ (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1948, dated 2nd April, 1948 and The Imported Apples and Pears (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) ^{1606 A} (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1949, dated 25th March, 1949, are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.
2. This Order may be cited as The Imported Apples and Pears (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Revocation) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 31st July, 1949.
