THE POULTRY (CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Poultry (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, shall be amended as follows:-

(a) by substituting for the definition of Poultry in Article 1 thereof, the following definition:-

"Poultry" includes domestic fowls, ducks, geese and turkeys (including imported turkeys) but does not include poultry reared in the Channel Islands, poultry which are less than eight days old or stock poultry."

(b) by deleting from the Schedule thereto Part II thereof.

2. This Order may be cited as The Poultry (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1949, and shall come into force on the 28th day of July, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.
