THE CONTROL OF THE SUPPLY OF WATER (GUERNSEY) ORDER,
1949.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, for the purpose of the equitable distribution of water, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the States Water Laws 1927-1947, the States Water Board is hereby authorised to withhold from any person or persons at its discretion the supply of water through its service mains.
2. This Order may be cited as The Control of the Supply of Water (Guernsey) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 16th day of August, 1949.
