THE SUGAR (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT)
ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, shall be amended as follows:-

- (a) by deleting from sub-paragraph (a) of the definition of "appropriate coupon" in Article 1 thereof the words "or 'S'" and from sub-paragraph (c) of that definition the words "or 'Quarter S'";
 - (b) by deleting from paragraphs (1) and (2) of Article 5 thereof the words "or 'S'" wherever they appear;
 - (c) by deleting from paragraph 1 of the Schedule thereto the words "or 'Quarter S'";
 - (d) by substituting for paragraph 2 of the said Schedule the following paragraph:-

"2. Amount against each appropriate coupon for
sugar in a Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B. 8A } 4 oz. net."
and against each appropriate coupon for
sugar marked 'Quarter R'.

2. This Order may be cited as The Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 14th day of August, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order reduces the sugar ration by 8 ozs. per four-week period or 2 ozs. per week, as from the 14th August, 1949, the beginning of Ration Period No. 4. As from that date coupons marked "S" or "Quarter S" will not be valid for the purchase of sugar.
