THE GENERAL FOOD (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:-

- (i) by deleting from Part VII (Canned Fish) of the Schedule thereto, the item relating to Kippered Herring fillets (kipper snacks);
- (ii) by deleting from the said Part VII of the Schedule thereto the words "(or Barracouta)" in the item relating to Snoek (or Barracouta and Kabeljou);
- (iii) by inserting in the said Part VII of the Schedule thereto the following entries:-

2. This Order may be cited as The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 14th day of August, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

This amending Order -

- (a) reduces the maximum prices of canned barracouta;
- (b) prescribes maximum prices for canned tunny (tuna); and
- (c) abolishes maximum prices for canned kippered herring fillets.
