THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) (GUERNSEY) REGULATIONS, 1945.

Order of the Competent Authority under paragraph (4) of Regulation 55.

Made on the 1st October, 1949.

WHEREAS it appears to the States Legislation Committee that, for the purpose of maintaining the supply of electricity in the Island of Alderney, such purpose being within the terms of the general purpose specified in sub-section (1) of Section one of the Supplies & Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945, as applied to the Bailiwick of Guernsey, it is necessary to take control on behalf of His Majesty of the undertaking known as the Alderney Light and Power Company Limited, whose registered office is situate at 40 Victoria Street in the said Island of Alderney, and that, for the purpose of exercising such control, it is expedient that that undertaking should, for the time being, be carried on in pursuance of an order made under paragraph (4) of Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945:

NOW THEREFORE, as Competent authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey in relation to the said Regulation 55, the States Legislation Committee, under and by virtue of paragraph (4) of that Regulation, hereby makes the following order:-

1. The person managing for the time being the States of Guernsey Electricity Department is hereby authorised, on behalf of His Majesty, to exercise in relation to the said undertaking known as the Alderney Light and Power Company Limited, such functions of control as may be requisite to enable him to ensure, for so long as this order remains operative, the continued production by

the said undertaking of electricity, the adequate supply thereof for use in the said Island of Alderney and the proper and business-like management of the affairs of the said undertaking.

2. This order shall commence to have effect on delivery at the registered office of the said undertaking of a certified copy of this order, and shall cease to be operative on the expiration of twenty-four hours after delivery at such registered office of a certified copy of an order revoking this order.

3. A certified copy of this order and of any order revoking, amending or varying this order shall be transmitted by J. M. Greffier to the Chairman of the Court of the Island of Alderney for registration on the records of that Island.
