THE UTILITY APPAREL (MAXIMUM PRICES AND CHARGES)
(BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 4)
ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall have effect subject to the following amendments:-
 - (i) there shall be substituted for the Table of Percentages set out in Article 2 thereof, the Table set out in the First Schedule to this Order.
 - (ii) there shall be substituted for the First Schedule thereto, the Second Schedule to this Order.
 2. This Order may be cited as The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1949, and shall come into force on the 26th September, 1949.

- (b) by reducing the retailers' permitted margins for other utility apparel, except fur apparel.
