THE FOOD (POINTS RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Food (Points Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:-

(a) by substituting in Part I of the Second Schedule thereto for the entries relating to luncheon meat, pork loaf, meat lunch and to canned pork or pork brawn, the following entries:-

(c) by deleting from the entry relating to snook (or barracouta) in Column 1 of Part II of the said Schedule the words "(or Barracouta)";

(d) by substituting for Part III of the said Schedule the following Part:-

2. This Order may be cited as The Food (Points Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 11th day of September, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order -

- (a) reduces the points values of luncheon meat, pork loaf, meat lunch, canned pork and pork brawn, and of the sweetened varieties of canned milk;
- (b) prescribes points values for Mexican meat and gravy, for vegetable and macaroni casserole with pork in tomato sauce, for imported canned fruit in 25 oz. containers and for 27 - 28 oz. and 29 - 30 oz. containers of luncheon meat, pork loaf and meat lunch; and
- (c) frees barracouta and several varieties of imported canned fruit from points rationing.
