STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

THE PRESERVES (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Preserves (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:-
    - (a) by deleting from the definition of "preserves" in paragraph (1) of Article 1 thereof the word "honey";
    - (b) by substituting for Article 2 thereof the following Article:-
 

"2. Except under and in accordance with the terms of a licence or authorisation granted by or on behalf of the Committee, no person shall sell or buy any jam or fruit curd manufactured in the United Kingdom or the Channel Islands or any mincemeat, at a price exceeding the maximum price applicable in accordance with the provisions of the First Schedule to this Order"; and
    - (c) by substituting for Part II of the First Schedule thereto, the Part so numbered in the Schedule to this Order.
  2. This Order may be cited as The Preserves (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 24th day of September, 1949.
