THE UTILITY FOOTWEAR (MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(NO. 2) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. (1) The maximum price to be charged, in the course of the business of a retailer, in respect of utility footwear (in this Order referred to as "goods") described in Column 1 and bearing a code number included in Column 2 of the Schedule hereto, shall be computed by adding to the purchase price paid or agreed to be paid to the manufacturer or wholesaler by the first purchaser (being a retailer) an amount equal to the appropriate percentage of such purchase price specified in Column 3 of the said Schedule: provided that the maximum price to be charged in respect of goods of such a description and bearing such a code number shall not exceed the appropriate price specified in Column 4 of the said Schedule with the addition of $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent of such price.
- (2) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (2) of Article 4, the maximum price to be charged in the course of the business of a retailer in respect of goods, not bearing a code number included in Column 2 of the Schedule hereto, shall be computed by adding to the purchase price paid or agreed to be paid to the manufacturer or wholesaler by the first purchaser (being a retailer) an amount equal -

in respect of women's footwear, to 36.66 per cent, and
in respect of other footwear, to 34.43 per cent.

of such purchase price.

- 1A. Where the letters MF have been applied to the sole of any goods described in Column 1 and bearing a code number included in Column 2 of the Schedule hereto, not being a code number followed by the suffix /MF, the maximum price shall be computed in accordance with the preceding Article as though those goods bore that code number followed by the suffix /MF.
2. The amounts specified in Column 4 of the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be adjusted as follows:-
 - (i) in the case of women's footwear, each such amount shall be deemed to be increased in respect of 5-fitting and 6-fitting shoes (or the equivalent thereof) by $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent and 5 per cent of such amount respectively, and in addition each such amount shall be deemed to be increased by 5 per cent thereof in respect of each whole size above size 8;
 - (ii) in the case of men's footwear, each such amount shall be deemed to be increased by 5 per cent thereof in respect of each whole size above size 11;
 - (iii) in the case of footwear marked "substandard" each such amount shall be deemed to be reduced by 20 per cent thereof.
3. Notwithstanding anything in this Order on a sale by a retailer of goods -
 - (a) the maximum price of which, calculated in accordance with the provisions of this Order, does not exceed the sum of 5s., the maximum price shall be rounded to the nearest $\frac{1}{2}$ d.;

(b) the maximum price of which, calculated in accordance with the provisions of this Order, exceeds the sum of 5s., the maximum price shall be rounded to the nearest 1d.

4. (1) In this Order -

"manufacturer" means any person who carries out, or procures or permits to be carried out, a process of manufacture whereby goods are produced;

"maximum price" means the price payable before any deductions by way of discount so, however, that the cost actually paid or incurred of delivering the goods to a retail customer may be excluded;

"purchase price" means the price inclusive of all delivery charges, payable after all deductions by way of discount, other than cash or settlement discounts not exceeding 6 1/4 per cent;

"retail customer" means a person to whom goods are sold by retail;

"utility footwear" has the meaning assigned in The Apparel and Textiles (Guernsey) Order, 1945.

(2) The Utility Footwear (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated 10th March, 1949, is hereby revoked.

(3) The Utility Footwear (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1948, as amended by The Utility Footwear (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1948, shall continue to have effect in relation to the sale of footwear bearing a code number which is included in the Schedule to that Order, but is not included in the Schedule to this Order.

5. This Order may be cited as The Utility Footwear (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 2) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 26th day of September, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order supersedes The Utility Footwear (Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949.

It reduces retailers' permitted margins for utility footwear except footwear in respect of which the manufacturer is on the Register of Manufacturers of Multiple-fitting Footwear kept by the Board of Trade for the purpose of The Footwear (Supply, Marking and Manufacturers' Prices) (No. 2) Order, 1949 of the United Kingdom.
