THE FUEL (MAXIMUM PRICES) (GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 5)  
ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. The Fuel (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1947, as amended, shall be further amended by substituting for the entries relating to Coke, locally produced, for use other than for horticultural purposes, the following entries:-
