THE SOAP (LICENSING OF MANUFACTURERS AND RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Soap (Licensing of Manufacturers and Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:-

- (a) by deleting from the first paragraph in Column 1 of the table in paragraph 1 of the Schedule thereto the numbers "29 and 30, 37 and 38, or 45 and 46,";
- (b) by substituting in the said table for the item relating to any appropriate coupon in a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 the following items:-

<u>"Appropriate Coupon.</u>	<u>No. of domestic rations.</u>
An appropriate coupon bearing the numbers 31 and 32, 39 and 40, or 47 and 48, in a Child's Ration Book R.B.2.	3
Any other appropriate coupon in a Child's Ration Book R.B.2.	2";

(c) by inserting immediately after paragraph (1) of Article 3 thereof the following paragraph:-

"(1A). The quantity of soap which may be obtained and supplied in respect of any ration period after ration period No. 6 under the authority of a permit SOAP 2A/49 shall be 13/12ths of the amount specified in that permit. Where the quantity of soap calculated in accordance with this paragraph includes a fraction of a ration, a fraction of a pound or a fraction of a pint such fraction shall be counted as a whole ration, pound or pint as the case may be.

For the avoidance of doubt the provisions of this paragraph do not apply to permits SOAP 2A/49 (S)."

3. This Order may be cited as The Soap (Licensing of Manufacturers and Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 6th day of November, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order -

- (a) increases the allowance of soap to holders of ration books R.B.1 and R.B.4 from seven to eight rations per eight weeks, and to holders of ration books R.B.2 from eight to nine rations per eight weeks;
- (b) increases the allowance of soap to holders of permits SOAP 2A/49 (but not to holders of permits SOAP 2A/49 (S)) by one-twelfth.

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
