THE IMPORTED WARE POTATOES (MAXIMUM PRICES) (GUERNSEY)
ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey: -

1. In this Order -

"Buy" includes offer or agree to buy and "sell" includes offer or agree to sell or expose for sale;

"Imported ware potatoes" means ware potatoes, other than seed or stockfeed potatoes, imported into the Island of Guernsey.

2. No person shall buy or sell any imported ware potatoes at a price exceeding 2½d. per lb.

3. The Imported Late Crop Potatoes (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, dated 10th May, 1949, is hereby revoked.

4. This Order may be cited as The Imported Ware Potatoes (Maximum Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, and shall come into force on the 17th day of October, 1949.
