GENERAL LICENCE DATED 8TH OCTOBER, 1949, MADE BY THE STATES OF GUERNSEY COMMITTEE FOR THE CONTROL OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES UNDER THE FOOD RATIONING (GENERAL PROVISIONS) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949.

1. Pursuant to Article 30 of The Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, the States of Guernsey Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities hereby authorises that, notwithstanding the provisions of Article 4 of The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, and Article 4 of The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, the maximum quantity of meat and bacon which may be supplied or obtained by any person for household consumption against an appropriate coupon specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Licence shall be the amount specified in relation thereto in the second column of the said Schedule.
2. This Licence shall come into operation on the 9th day of October, 1949.

2. An appropriate coupon for bacon -
- (a) numbered 21, 22, 23 or 24 in a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2, or a Junior Ration Book R.B.4;
  - (b) in a Duty Ration Card R.B.8R being a coupon relating to any week in the ration period beginning 9th October, 1949;
  - (c) in a Form R.B.12 if the whole or any part of the period specified on the form (or in the case of a double form on that half of the form of which the coupon forms part) falls within the ration period beginning 9th October, 1949;
  - (d) in a Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A valid at any time during the ration period beginning 9th October, 1949.
- 4 oz. of bacon free of bone.
- 2 oz. of bacon free of bone.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This General Licence -

- (a) increases the value of the meat coupons for weeks 21, 22 and 23 (i.e. the three weeks beginning 9th October, 1949) in Ration Books R.B.1, R.B.2, R.B.4, R.B.7, Duty Ration Cards R.B.8R and R.B.8X, Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A and Form R.B.12 from 8½d. to 9½d. or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey from 10½d. to 11½d. and the corresponding coupons in Form R.G.44 from 1s. 4d. to 1s. 6d.;
- (b) increases the value of the bacon coupons for weeks 21, 22, 23 and 24 (i.e. the four weeks beginning 9th October, 1949) in Ration Books R.B.1, R.B.2, R.B.4, Duty Ration Card R.B.8R and Form R.B.12 from 3 oz. to 4 oz. and the corresponding coupons in Form R.B.8A from 1 oz. to 2 oz.
