THE SUGAR (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 2)
ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

- 1647
1. The Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended by substituting in paragraph (1) of Article 6 thereof for the expression " $\frac{5}{32}$ oz." wherever it occurs the expression " $\frac{1}{8}$ oz."
 2. This Order shall come into operation on the 16th day of October, 1949, and may be cited as the Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1949.
