THE GENERAL FOOD (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 5) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:-
 - (a) by substituting in Part IX (Fats) of the Schedule thereto for the maximum retail price per lb. of "2/4d." as regards Butter, imported, the maximum retail price per lb. of "2/-";
 - (b) by deleting from Part X (Cereals and Cereal Products) of the said Schedule the items relating to Macaroni;
 - (c) by substituting in Part XIII (Cheese) of the said Schedule for the maximum retail price per lb. of "1/8d." the maximum retail price per lb. of "1/4d."
 2. This Order may be cited as The General Food (Maximum Retail Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 5) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 31st October, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This amending Order -

- (a) reduces the maximum retail price of Imported Butter to 2/- per lb;
- (b) releases Macaroni from price control; and
- (c) reduces the maximum retail price of Processed Cheese and other varieties of Cheese to which the Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, applies to 1/4d. per lb.
