THE IMPORTED CARROTS (MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES) (GUERNSEY) ORDER,
1949.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. In this Order -

"Imported" means imported into the Island of Guernsey and the expression "importer" shall be construed accordingly;

"buy" includes offer or agree to buy and "sell" includes offer or agree to sell or expose for sale;

"retailer" means a person who sells imported carrots to a person buying otherwise than for the purpose of re-sale.

2. No person shall sell or buy any imported carrots at a price exceeding the maximum retail price calculated in accordance with the provisions of Article 3 of this Order.

3. The maximum retail price shall be -

(a) in the case of a sale made by a retailer who was not the importer of the carrots, an amount not exceeding the price paid by him for the carrots plus an amount equal to 40 per cent thereof;

(b) in the case of a sale made by a retailer who was the importer of the carrots, an amount not exceeding the cost of the carrots as delivered into Guernsey plus an amount equal to 50 per cent thereof;

In the calculation of a maximum retail price any fraction of a penny less than one half shall be counted as a halfpenny and any fraction of a penny greater than one half shall be counted as a penny.

4. This Order may be cited as The Imported Carrots (Maximum Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1949, and shall come into force on the 21st day of November, 1949.
