THE FATS, CHEESE AND TEA (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

- 1643
1. The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:-
 - (a) by inserting in the definition of cheese in Article 1 thereof after the words "with the exception of" the words "Imported blue vein, Stilton, Blue Cheshire.";
 - (b) by deleting from Article 1 thereof the definition of specified period;
 - (c) by deleting therefrom Articles 5, 8, 10 and 13.
 2. This Order may be cited as The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1949 and shall come into operation on the 6th day of November, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order frees imported blue vein, Stilton and Blue Cheshire cheese from the provisions of The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, and revokes provisions which limited the amounts of fats, cheese and tea permitted to be used in establishments.
