THE SUGAR (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended by deleting from Article 6 thereof paragraphs (1), (2), (3), (4) and (5). - 1644
2. The Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1949, dated 15th October, 1949, is hereby revoked. S. I. 108
3. This Order may be cited as The Sugar (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1949 and shall come into operation on the 6th day of November, 1949.
