THE BACON (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT  
NO. 2) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended by substituting in the Second Column of the Schedule thereto (which specifies the amount of the bacon ration) for the amount "3 oz." in relation to each appropriate coupon in a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Junior Ration Book R.B.4, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2, a Form R.B.12 and a Duty Ration Card R.B.8R and for the amount "1 oz." in relation to each appropriate coupon in a Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A the amounts "4 oz." and "2 oz." respectively.
  2. Notwithstanding anything contained in Article 1 of this Order, the maximum amount of bacon which may be obtained or supplied against an appropriate coupon for bacon in any of the ration documents mentioned in Article 1 of this Order relating to the week beginning 13th November, 1949, and valid for use during the said week and the following week, but not used during the said week beginning 13th November, 1949, shall be 3 ozs. net in respect of an appropriate coupon in General Ration Book R.B.1, a Junior Ration Book R.B.4, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2, a Form R.B.12 and a Duty Ration Card R.B.8R and 1 oz. net in respect of an appropriate coupon in a Leave or Duty Card R.B.8A.
  3. The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1949, dated 10th August, 1949, is hereby revoked.
  4. This Order may be cited as The Bacon (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 20th day of November, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order increases, as from 20th November, 1949, the amount of the bacon ration which may be obtained against appropriate coupons (a) in Ration Books R.B.1, R.B.2, R.B.4, Duty Ration Card R.B.8R and Form R.B.12 from 3 ozs. to 4 ozs. per week and (b) in a Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A from 1 oz. to 2 oz. per week. Appropriate coupons valid for use during the week beginning 13th November, 1949, and the following week, but not used in the week beginning 13th November, 1949, are valid, if used in the week beginning 20th November, 1949, for 3 ozs. only in the case of Ration Books R.B.1, R.B.2, R.B.4, Duty Ration Card R.B.8R and Form R.B.12 and 1 oz. only in the case of a Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A.
