THE POULTRY (CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICES) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)  
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1949.

**REVOKED - See S.I. 34 (1950).**

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

- S.I. 23.
1. The Poultry (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:-
    - (a) by substituting for the definition of "imported turkeys" in Article 1 thereof, the following definition:-
 

"Imported turkeys" means turkeys which have been imported into the Bailiwick of Guernsey from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man, Eire, the Channel Islands, whether direct or otherwise but does not include turkeys imported direct from France."
    - (b) by substituting for the Schedule thereto, the Schedule to this Order.
  2. This Order may be cited as The Poultry (Control and Maximum Prices) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1949, and shall come into force on the 25th day of November, 1949.

NOTE: - (1) The maximum prices of turkeys imported direct from France are those specified in Part I of the Schedule.

(2) No charge additional to the maximum price shall be made for killing, plucking, trussing, drawing or for packing or packages, except that on a first hand sale, or a sale by a wholesaler to another wholesaler, or by a wholesaler to a retailer, the seller may make a reasonable additional charge for the cost of providing a returnable package for the poultry, provided that the sum so charged shall be repaid by the seller to the buyer on the return of the package at the expense of the buyer in such condition as is reasonable having regard to its condition when supplied and to ordinary wear and tear.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order increases the maximum prices of poultry other than imported turkeys, poussins (live or dead), cooked poultry or parts of cooked poultry by 2d. per lb. It also excludes French turkeys from the definition of "Imported Turkeys" so that the maximum prices for such turkeys are the same as for those produced in the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man and Eire. Poultry produced in the Channel Islands remains free from price control.
