THE FATS, CHEESE AND TEA (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF
GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 4) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:-

(a) by substituting in the table in the Schedule thereto for the entries relating to tea, the entries in the Schedule to this Order;

(b) by substituting for paragraph 1 of the Schedule thereto the following paragraph:-

"1. The amount of tea against each appropriate coupon in a form R.G.64 shall be $\frac{1}{2}$ oz."

2. This Order may be cited as The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 4th day of December, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order increases the value of tea coupons in General Ration Books R.B.1 and Junior Ration Books R.B.4 relating to the 4-week periods commencing 4th December, 1949, 29th January, 1950 and 26th March, 1950 (ration periods Nos. 8, 10 and 12 respectively), from 2 oz. to 3 oz.; and also increases from 4th December, 1949, the value of tea coupons in Duty Ration Cards R.B.8R and Temporary Ration Cards R.B.12 from 2 oz. to 2½ oz..

The value of coupons in Forms R.G.64 are at the same time reduced from 1 oz. to ½ oz.
