THE CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR FOOD (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
DIRECTIONS, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, and pursuant to Article 30 of The Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, we hereby give the following Directions:-

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 4 of The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, which prescribes the fats ration, the maximum quantity of cooking fats which may be obtained or supplied for household consumption against any appropriate coupon specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be the amount specified in relation thereto in the said Schedule.
2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 3 of The Rationing (Personal Points) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, an appropriate coupon marked "D" shall represent $1\frac{1}{2}$ personal points and an appropriate coupon marked "E" shall represent 4 personal points in the following cases:-
 - (a) an appropriate coupon numbered 8 from a General Ration Book R.B.1, Junior Ration Book R.B.4, Child's Ration Book R.B.2 or Weekly Seaman's Book R.B.6;
 - (b) an un-numbered appropriate coupon (including an appropriate coupon marked R.B.12S) forming part of, or, as the case may be, produced in accordance with paragraph (i) or (iii) of subparagraph (d) of paragraph (2) of Article 5 of the said Order, with a Form R.B.12, and valid under the terms of that Article at any time during ration period number 8;
 - (c) an un-numbered appropriate coupon used by or on behalf of a member of H.M. Navy and produced together with a Duty Ration Card R.B.8R which is available for use at any time during ration period number 8;
 - (d) an appropriate coupon marked R.B.8R in a Duty Ration Card R.B.8R which is available for use at any time during ration period number 8.
3. Nothing in Article 11 of The Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, which relates to the invalidation by establishments of residents' coupons shall require or authorise the licensee of an establishment to invalidate the appropriate coupon for cooking fats in any person's ration document if the appropriate coupon which, but for the provisions of this Article, would fall to be invalidated under the terms of the said Article 11 is an appropriate coupon for cooking fats specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. These Directions may be cited as The Christmas and New Year Food (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Directions, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 4th day of December, 1949.

THE SCHEDULE.

<u>Appropriate Coupon.</u>	<u>Amount of Cooking Fats.</u>
An appropriate coupon for fats -	
(a) numbered 29, 30, 31 or 32 in a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 or a Junior Ration Book R.B.4.	5 ozs.
(b) in a Duty Ration Card R.B.8R valid for use during the ration period beginning 4th December, 1949.	
(c) in a Form R.B.12 if the whole or any part of the period specified on the form (or in the case of a double form on that half of the form of which the coupon forms part) falls within the ration period beginning 4th December, 1949.	

Where a form R.G.48 or R.G.48E relating to cooking fats is produced with a ration document the amount of cooking fats obtainable against the appropriate coupons for fats specified above shall be increased as specified on the form.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Directions, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Directions make provision for increased rations of cooking fats and chocolate and sugar confectionery during the Christmas and New Year period.
