THE CONTROL OF LIGHTING (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authority as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, I hereby make the following Order as regards the Island of Guernsey:-

1. No person shall cause or permit -

- (a) the illumination of any sky sign, fascia or advertisement;
- (b) the display of any light outside or at the entrance to any premises or on any hoarding or similar structure;
- (c) the illumination of the internal part of any premises for the purpose of advertisement or display to persons outside the premises;

between the hours of 3.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

2. Nothing in this Order shall prohibit the doing of anything under the authority of a licence issued by or on behalf of the States' Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities hereunder and in accordance with any conditions attaching thereto.

3. This Order may be cited as The Control of Lighting (Guernsey) Order, 1949, and shall come into force on the 5th day of December, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order prohibits except under licence issued by the States' Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities -

- (a) the illumination of any sky sign, fascia or advertisement;
- (b) The display of any light outside or at the entrance to any premises or on any hoarding; and
- (c) the illumination of the internal part of any premises for the purpose of advertisement or display to persons outside the premises

on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays between the hours of 3.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m.
