GENERAL LICENCE DATED 3rd DECEMBER, 1949, MADE BY THE STATES  
OF GUERNSEY COMMITTEE FOR THE CONTROL OF ESSENTIAL  
COMMODITIES UNDER THE FOOD RATIONING (GENERAL PROVISIONS)  
(BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1949.

1. Pursuant to Articles 28 and 30 of The Food Rationing (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, the States of Guernsey Committee for the Control of Essential Commodities hereby authorises and directs that as from the date of the coming into operation of this Licence until 31st December, 1949, paragraph (2) of Article 2 of The Food (Points Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall have effect as if the following paragraph were substituted therefor, namely:-

(2) For the purposes of this Article "consumer" shall mean, in respect of the sale of pre-packed egg products to any person by a retailer, a person who is the holder of a Child's Ration Book R.B.2 or a Ration Book R.B.7 and such person is registered with that retailer for the supply of eggs in shell.

The conditions under which pre-packed egg products may be sold by a retailer to such consumers (and bought by such consumers from the retailer) ration free are as follows:-

- (1) not more than two packages shall be obtained by or supplied to any such consumer in the 8 week period ending 31st December, 1949;
- (2) on or before supplying any such package to a consumer the retailer shall mark, in respect of each package so supplied, the letters "D.E." in the space bearing in large figures the number 7 opposite the word "Eggs" on the appropriate page of coupons contained in the Ration Book R.B.2 or R.B.7, as the case may be, held by the consumer.

Where the letters "D.E." have been marked in such space as aforesaid it shall be presumed that one package has already been obtained and supplied for each marking of the letters "D.E."

2. This Licence shall come into operation on the 4th day of December, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This General Licence increases the number of packages of dried egg which may be supplied ration free to holders of Ration Books R.B.2 and R.B.7 during the 8 week ration period ending 31st December, 1949, from 1 to 2.
