THE MEAT (RATIONING) (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER, 1949.

As Competent Authorities as regards the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney and as regards the Island of Alderney respectively in relation to Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1945, we hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended by substituting for paragraphs 1, 2 and 4 of the Schedule thereto (which specifies the amount of the meat ration) the following paragraphs:-
 - "1. Amount against the appropriate coupons relating to each week in a -

General Ration Book R.B.1	}	ls. 7d. maximum price (9½d. maximum retail price for each coupon) or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey ls. 10d. maximum price (11d. maximum retail price for each coupon).
Junior Ration Book R.B.4	}

Duty Ration Card R.B.8R	}	
 2. Amount against each appropriate coupon in a -

Child's Ration Book R.B.2	}	9½d. maximum retail price or where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey 11d. maximum retail price.

Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A		
Duty Ration Card R.B.8X		
 4. Amount against an appropriate coupon on a form R.G.44) ls. 7d. maximum retail price."
2. For the avoidance of doubt, the maximum quantity of meat which may be obtained or supplied against an appropriate coupon for meat in any of the ration documents mentioned in Article 1 of this Order relating to the week beginning 27th November, 1949, and valid for use during the said week and the following week, but not used during the said week beginning 27th November, 1949, shall be the maximum retail price applicable in relation thereto immediately prior to the coming into operation of this Order.
3. The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 1949, dated 30th July, 1949, is hereby revoked.
4. This Order may be cited as The Meat (Rationing) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 4th day of December, 1949.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This amending Order increases, as from the 4th December, 1949, the amount of the meat ration which may be obtained against appropriate coupons in Ration Books R.B.1 and R.B.4, Forms R.B.12 and R.C.44 and Duty Ration Card R.B.8R from ls. 5d. to ls. 7d. maximum retail price. The value of appropriate coupons in the Child's Ration Book R.B.2, Ration Book R.B.7, Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A and Duty Ration Card R.B.8X is increased from 8½d. to 9½d.

Coupons valid for use during the week beginning 27th November, 1949, and the following week but not used in the week beginning 27th November, 1949, remain valid for 8½d. maximum retail price only, if used in the week beginning 4th December, 1949.

This Order also provides that where the meat supplied is pork produced in the Bailiwick of Guernsey the amount of the ration which may be obtained against appropriate coupons in Ration Books R.B.1 and R.B.4, Form R.B.12 and Duty Ration Card R.B.8R is ls. 10d. maximum retail price and in Child's Ration Book R.B.2, Ration Book R.B.7, Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A and Duty Ration Card R.B.8X, 11d. maximum retail price.
