**The Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (Fees)
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 2013**

Coming into operation

3rd June, 2013

THE HOME DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 5 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 as extended to Guernsey by the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (Guernsey) Order 2003^a, and by section 166(3) of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 as extended to Guernsey by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 2011^b hereby makes the following Order:-

Amendment of the Fees Regulations.

1. The Fees Regulations are amended as follows –
 - (a) regulation 1(1)(d) is deleted, and
 - (b) the table in the Schedule is replaced by the following table -

Interpretation.

2. (1) In this Order -

"the Fees Regulations" means the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (Fees) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2011^c,

and other expressions shall have the same meaning as in the Fees Regulations.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^d applies to the interpretation of this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

This Order increases the fees payable in connection with applications for leave to remain in the Bailiwick of Guernsey for an indefinite period, leave to remain and variation of leave to remain for a limited period and for variation of leave to enter for a limited period. The Order also removes the fees previously charged for the affixing of an indefinite leave stamp in a person's passport.
