**The Health and Safety (Fees) Order, 2013**

*Made* 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2013  
*Coming into operation* 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2013  
*Laid before the States* 2013

**THE COMMERCE AND EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1 and 3(1) of the Health and Safety (Fees) (Guernsey) Law, 1993<sup>a</sup>, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Fees to be payable under Explosives Law.**

1. The following fees shall be payable under and for the purposes of the following provisions of the Explosives (Guernsey) Law, 1905<sup>b</sup> -

- (i) under article VIII ("licences pour provision"), a fee of - £ 40.00
- (ii) under article XXIX ("honoraries"), a fee of -

**Fees to be payable under Petroleum Law.**

2. The following fees shall be payable under and for the purposes of the following provisions of the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Huiles ou Essences Minérales ou autres substances de la même nature, 1924"<sup>c</sup> -

- (i) under article 2(1) (fees payable in respect of discharge of inflammable oils), an annual fee of £25.00,
- (ii) under article 2(3) (fees for application for licences for storage of inflammable oils), a fee of -
 

for a quantity not exceeding 500 gallons	£ 25.00
for a quantity not exceeding 2,000 gallons	£ 40.00
for a quantity not exceeding 20,000 gallons	£ 50.00

(iii) under article 2(4) (fees for services rendered by an Inspector in connection with construction of places for storage of inflammable oils), a fee of £50.00 per hour or part thereof, and

(iv) under article 2(8) (fees payable upon grant or renewal of licence for storage of inflammable oils), a fee of –

for a quantity not exceeding 500 gallons	£ 25.00
for quantities not exceeding 2,000 gallons	£ 40.00
for quantities not exceeding 20,000 gallons	£ 50.00
for quantities not exceeding 50,000 gallons	£ 75.00
for quantities not exceeding 100,000 gallons	£100.00
for quantities greater than 100,000 gallons	£200.00.

**Fees to be payable under Health and Safety legislation.**

3. The following fees shall be payable to the States for the grant, renewal or variation of the following licences, or applications therefore, or the provision of the following services or documents, under or for the purposes of the Health, Safety and Welfare of Employees Law, 1950<sup>d</sup>, the Health and Safety at Work etc. (Guernsey) Law, 1979<sup>e</sup> and any Ordinance or other subordinate legislation made under them -

for the granting of a scaffold permit	£ 25.00
for the analysis of samples referred for specialist examination, the actual cost plus	£ 20.00

for a Poisonous Substances Importers Licence £100.00  
 for a Poisonous Substances Spraying Contractors Licence £ 75.00  
 for a Poisonous Substances Use of Licensed Chemicals £ 20.00  
 for the provision of factual reports (on the basis of time expended  
 in their preparation) at £50.00 per hour or part thereof.

**Interpretation.**

4. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>f</sup> applies to the interpretation of this Order.

(2) Any reference in this Order to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

**Repeal.**

5. The Health and Safety (Fees) Order, 1994<sup>g</sup> is repealed.

**Citation and Commencement.**

6. This Order may be cited as the Health and Safety (Fees) Order, 2013 and shall come into force on 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2013.
