**The Temporary Prohibition of the Importation of Animals  
from Alderney (No 2) Order, 2013**

**THE COMMERCE AND EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 11(1) of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952<sup>a</sup>, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Prohibition of the importation of animals from Alderney.**

1. The importation into the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou of cattle, sheep, goats and pigs from Alderney is prohibited.

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>b</sup> applies to the interpretation of this Order.

(2) Any reference in this Order to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.


**Citation.**

3. This Order may be cited as the Temporary Prohibition of the Importation of Animals from Alderney (No 2) Order, 2013.

**Commencement and expiry.**

4. This Order shall come into force on 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2013 and shall cease to have effect on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2014.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order prohibits the importation of cattle, sheep, goats and pigs from Alderney until the end of January, 2014. This is an extension of precautionary measures that came into effect on 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2013 to protect the health of animals in Guernsey and it is intended to allow time for further tests to be carried out on animals in Alderney following inconclusive results obtained from some of the tests carried out on those animals in November.
