The Liquor Licensing (Fees) Regulations, 2014

THE HOME DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 84(4) of the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

Amendment of fees.

1. The Fourth Schedule to the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006, is amended in accordance with the Schedule to these Regulations.

Interpretation.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as in the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, 2006.

(2) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law 1948^b shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto or from time to time amended, replaced, re-enacted, extended or applied.

Revocation.

3. The Liquor Licensing (Fees) Regulations, 2013^c and The Liquor Licensing (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2013^d are hereby revoked.

Commencement and Citation.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Fees) Regulations, 2014 and shall come into force on the 1st June, 2014.
