**The Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (Fees)  
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 2014**

**THE HOME DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 5 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 as extended to Guernsey by the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (Guernsey) Order 2003<sup>a</sup>, and by section 166(3) of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 as extended to Guernsey by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 2011<sup>b</sup> hereby makes the following Order:-

**Amendment of the Fees Order.**

1. The Fees Order is amended as follows –
  - (a) in article 1(1) of the Fees Order, for "paragraphs", substitute "articles",
  - (b) revoke article 1(2) of the Fees Order, and
  - (c) the table in the Schedule to the Fees Order is replaced with the following table –

Leave to remain in the Bailiwick for an indefinite period.	£1,093.00
Leave to remain in the Bailiwick for a limited period.	£601.00
Variation of leave to remain the Bailiwick for a limited period.	£601.00
Variation of leave to enter the Bailiwick for a limited period.	£601.00

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) In this Order, "**the Fees Order**" means the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (Fees) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2011<sup>c</sup>, and other expressions shall have the same meaning as in the Fees Order.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>d</sup> applies to the interpretation of this Order.

**Revocation.**

3. The Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (Fees) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 2013<sup>e</sup> is revoked.

**Citation.**

4. This Order may be cited as the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (Fees) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 2014.

**Commencement.**

5. This Order shall come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2013.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

Article 1(a) of this Order corrects a reference in the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (Fees) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2013 ("**Fees Order**") to "paragraphs" (should be articles) of that Order.

Article 1(b) of this Order revokes a provision in the Fees Order restricting the fee prescribed for a dependant to situations where the dependant makes an application at the same time as the principal applicant. The fee is now the same for a dependant,

regardless whether the dependant's application is made at the same time as the application by the principal applicant, or at a different time.

Article 1(c) of this Order increases the fees payable in connection with applications for leave to remain in the Bailiwick of Guernsey for an indefinite period, for leave to remain or variation of leave to remain for a limited period or for variation of leave to enter for a limited period. The same fee applies to applicants and dependants of applicants.

Article 2 of this Order sets out the interpretation provisions.

Article 3 of this Order revokes the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (Fees) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 2013, which is spent.

Articles 4 and 5 are the citation and commencement provisions respectively.

This Order will come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2014.
