

**The Traffic Temporary (Longue Hougue Lane) Regulations,
2014**

Made

15th July, 2014

Coming into operation

1st August, 2014

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by article X of the Ordinance relative au Traffic Vehiculaire en cette Ile, 1929^a and section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950^b, and of all powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in the localities of this Island referred to in these regulations:-

Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.

1. The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989^c, is amended by inserting, immediately after paragraph 1 in Part VIII of Schedule 1, the following paragraph -

"2. Longue Hougue Lane. This paragraph applies to all vehicles and animals, except for access to premises on Longue Hougue Lane."

Interpretation.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**Department**" means the Environment Department,

"**enactment**" means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation,
and

"**subordinate legislation**" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^d applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

(3) Unless the context requires otherwise, references in these Regulations to any enactment are references thereto as amended, varied, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Revocation.

3. The Traffic Temporary (Longue Hougue Lane) Regulations, 2010^e are hereby revoked.

Citation.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Temporary (Longue Hougue Lane) Regulations, 2014.

Commencement and Expiry

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st August, 2014 and cease to have effect -

- (a) at the end of the period of 12 months commencing with the date on which they are made, or
- (b) on any earlier date determined by Order of the Department.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

The purpose of these Regulations is to temporarily amend the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, in order to further assess the effect of prohibiting 'through' traffic in Longue Hougue Lane, a road which is heavily used by large goods vehicles. Access by vehicles to properties and businesses will continue to be permitted on Longue Hougue Lane.

These Regulations come into force on the 1st August, 2014.
