

**The Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical  
Benefit) (Amendment) (No.5) Regulations, 2014**

**THE SOCIAL SECURITY DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 10 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990 as amended<sup>a</sup>, section 1 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited Lists) Ordinance, 2004<sup>b</sup> and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Amendment.**

1. In the Schedule to the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 2004<sup>c</sup>, as amended add the rows set out in Schedule 1 to these Regulations, under the appropriate headings.

**Citation, commencement and extent.**

3. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment) (No.5) Regulations, 2014 and shall come into force on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of September 2014.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

## SCHEDULE 1

### Regulation 1

<b>British National Formulary (BNF) Section</b>	<b>Heading</b>	<b>Pharmaceutical Benefit</b>
10.1.3	Drugs that suppress the rheumatic disease process	Golimumab Injection 50mg (For initiation only by publically -funded Consultant Rheumatologist)
6.1.1	Insulins	Insulin Degludec Injection 100 units per ml cartridges and pre-filled pen (For initiation only by publically-funded Consultant Diabetologist and only for people with Type 1 Diabetes)
5.1	Antibacterial drugs	Rifaximin Tablets 550mg (For initiation only by publically-funded Consultant Gastroenterologist or Hepatologist)

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These Regulations add to the limited list of drugs and medicines available as pharmaceutical benefit which may be ordered to be supplied by medical prescriptions issued by medical practitioners.

These Regulations came into operation on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2014.
