

Waste Disposal Charges Regulations, 2014

THE PUBLIC SERVICES DEPARTMENT, in its capacity as Waste Disposal Authority^a under and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 32(2)(c) and 72 of the Environmental Pollution (Guernsey) Law, 2004^b and all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Waste Disposal Charges.

1. The charges set out in the Schedule to these Regulations are prescribed for the purposes of section 32(2)(c) of the Environmental Pollution (Guernsey) Law, 2004 in respect of the disposal of waste of the types, and at the sites, referred to therein.

Revocations.

2. The Waste Disposal Charges Regulations, 2013^c are revoked.

Interpretation.

3. (1) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^d applies to the


interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

(2) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation and commencement.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Waste Disposal Charges Regulations, 2014 and shall come into force on the 1 January, 2015.

SCHEDULE

Regulation 1

WASTE DISPOSAL CHARGES

The following charges, or rates of charge, apply in relation to the disposal of the types of waste at the sites indicated, subject to a minimum charge of £10 for each weighed load with the exception of Green and Inert waste which are subject to a minimum charge of £5.

(a) *Disposal at Mont Cuet -*

- (i) standard waste - £171.78 per tonne
- (ii) waste subject to contamination - £257.72 per tonne
- (iii) notifiable special waste - £343.09 per tonne
- (iv) non-notifiable pre-sorted special waste - £171.78 per tonne
- (v) commercial green waste - £29.62 per tonne
- (vi) private household waste - £2 per bag
- (vii) street cleaning - £29.62 per tonne
- (viii) sewage and gully sludges - £29.62 per tonne
- (ix) blended cover material - £10.00 per tonne
- (x) reload cover material - £62.07 per load

(b) *Disposal at Longue Hougue -*

- (i) standard waste - £14.05 per tonne
- (ii) soil with turf/vegetation - £64.33 per tonne
- (iii) reload charge - £18.06 per load
- (iv) weigh facility only - £5.00
- (v) private household inert waste - £1.00 per bag

- (c) *Disposal at Waste Segregation Facility -*
- (i) standard waste - £171.78 per tonne
 - (ii) glass - £40.00 per tonne
 - (iii) tins - £40.00 per tonne
 - (iv) mixed - £40.00 per tonne
 - (v) weigh facility only - £5.00
 - (vi) reload charge - £62.07 per load
- (d) *Disposal at States Works, La Hure Mare -*
- Commercial quantities of polystyrene - £10.00 per load
