**The Public Highways (Al Fresco Licences)
(Fees) Regulations, 2014**

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1 and 5 of the Fees, Charges and Penalties (Guernsey) Law, 2007^a as amended, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

Fees for application for al fresco licence.

1. In section 13(1) (fees) of the Public Highways (Temporary Closure) Ordinance, 1999^b, for each reference to "£100" substitute "£160".

Application of new fees.

2. For the avoidance of doubt, the new fees substituted by regulation 1 apply in relation to fees payable to Her Majesty's Greffier in relation to an application to the Royal Court -

- (a) for the grant of an al fresco licence,
- (b) to vary the conditions attached to an al fresco licence,
or
- (c) to renew an al fresco licence,

as the case may be, made under the Public Highways (Temporary Closure) Ordinance, 1999 on or after the 24th November, 2014.

Interpretation.

3. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**enactment**" means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation,
and

"**subordinate legislation**" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect.

(2) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

(3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Highways (Al Fresco Licences) (Fees) Regulations, 2014.

Commencement.

5. These Regulations shall come into force on 24th November, 2014.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations)

These Regulations increase the fees payable to Her Majesty's Greffier on applications made to the Royal Court in respect of an application for the grant, variation of the conditions or renewal of an al fresco licence under the Public Highways (Temporary) (Closure) Ordinance, 1999.

These Regulations come into force on the 24th November, 2014.
