

The Health Service (Payment of Authorised Appliance Suppliers) (Amendment No.2) Regulations, 2014

THE SOCIAL SECURITY DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 19 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990, as amended^a, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment.

1. The three Schedules to the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Appliance Suppliers) Regulations, 2003^b are revoked and replaced by the three Schedules set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

Interpretation.

2. (1) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these regulations to any enactment or regulations shall be construed as including a reference to that enactment or those regulations, as the case may be, as amended,

(2) The Interpretation Guernsey Law, 1948^c shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

Revocation.

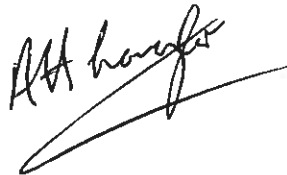
3. The Health Service (Payment of Authorised Appliance Suppliers) (Amendment) Regulations, 2014^d are revoked.

Citation, commencement and extent.

4. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Appliance Suppliers) (Amendment No.2) Regulations, 2014 and shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 2015.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations revoke and replace the Schedules to the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Appliance Suppliers) Regulations, 2003. The Schedules set out the payments which may be made out of the Health Service Benefit Fund for the supply of medical appliances.

These Regulations come into force on 1st January 2015.

On a non-business day, between 9am and 11pm, except whilst the premises are open for the purposes of any scheme prepared by the Authority under Part II of the Schedule to the Health Service (Authorised Appliance Suppliers) Regulations, 1990.	£29.17
On any day between 11pm and 9am of the next day or such earlier time at which the premises are opened for the supply of medical appliances (on any day except a non-business day).	£75.72
