**The Traffic Temporary (Clearways) (Hougue Ricart)
Regulations, 2015***Made*6th January, 2015*Coming into operation*19th January, 2015

THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by article X of the Ordinance relative au Traffic Vehiculaire en cette Ile, 1929^a, section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950, as amended^b, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island -

Restrictions on stopping at Hougue Ricart.

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the States Environment Department, cause or permit that vehicle or animal to stop on any part of the carriageway of a highway specified in column 1 of the Schedule to these Regulations, otherwise than to permit pedestrians to cross at pedestrian crossings, on any day other than a Saturday, Sunday, Good Friday, Christmas Day, any day specified as a public holiday in section 1 of the Public Holidays Ordinance, 1994^c or any day that is a school holiday of the Vale Primary School, between the hours specified in column 2 of the Schedule to these Regulations.

Interpretation.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**animal**" does not include a dog or a cat,

"**enactment**" means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation,

"**highway**" means a public highway and includes the whole area of any highway open to public vehicular or pedestrian traffic,

"**subordinate legislation**" means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect, and

"**vehicle**" includes a mechanically propelled vehicle, a cycle, an animal drawn vehicle and a hand drawn vehicle.

(2) For the purposes of these Regulations, a vehicle or animal is caused or permitted to "**stop**" if it is stationary other than so as to comply with a legal requirement or to avoid a collision or interference with another vehicle or animal, or with a person.

(3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^d applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

(4) Unless the context requires otherwise, references in these Regulations to any enactment are references thereto as amended, varied, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Temporary (Hougue Ricart) Regulations, 2015.

Commencement and Expiry

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 15th January, 2015 and shall cease to have effect -

- (a) at the end of the period of 12 months commencing with the date on which they are made, or
- (b) on any earlier date determined by order of the Department.

(1) Location	(2) Hours
Hougue Ricart, Vale (from a point 15m to the north of its junction with La Croix du Bois to a point 55m further to the north)	(a) 8.30 a.m. - 9.00 a.m. (b) 2.45 p.m. - 3.30 p.m.

This paragraph does not apply on a Saturday or Sunday nor during the school holidays of the Vale Primary School.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

This Regulation makes provision for the temporary introduction of a time restricted

clearway in the section of Hougue Ricart broadly between the filter and the Infants School car park exit, the intention being to improve traffic flow in this road during the periods around school start and finish times.
