

**The Public Health (Vessels) (Guernsey) (Amendment)  
Order, 2015**

<i>Made</i>	21 <sup>st</sup> January, 2015

THE HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT, after consultation with the Home Department, and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 2 of the Public Health (Vessels and Aircraft) (Guernsey) Law, 1950<sup>a</sup>, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Amendment of the 1974 Order.**

1. Article 5(1) of the Public Health (Vessels) (Guernsey) Order, 1974<sup>b</sup> is amended by inserting, immediately after the words "on board", the words "or disembarking from".

**Interpretation.**

2. (1) In this Order, unless the context requires otherwise –

"enactment" means any Law, Ordinance or subordinate legislation,

and

**"subordinate legislation"** means any regulation, rule, order, rule of court, resolution, scheme, byelaw or other instrument made under any enactment and having legislative effect.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>c</sup> applies to the interpretation of this Order throughout the Islands of Guernsey, Herm, Jethou and Alderney as that Law applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

(3) Any reference in this Order to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

**Citation.**

3. This Order may be cited as the Public Health (Vessels) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Order, 2015.

**Commencement.**


4. This Order comes into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2015.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends article 5(1) of the Public Health (Vessels) (Guernsey) Order, 1974, to clarify that the power and duty of a medical officer to examine persons under that provision apply not only in relation to persons on board vessels, but also to persons disembarking from vessels.

This Order comes into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2015.
