The Boarding Permit Fees Order, 2015*Made**5th February, 2015**Coming into operation**1st April, 2015**Laid before the States**2015*

THE COMMERCE AND EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 17 of the Tourist Law, 1948^a as amended^b and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Fee payable by applicants for a boarding permit.

1. An applicant for a boarding permit shall pay to the Department on application for a permit valid from 1st April 2015 to 31st March 2016, or part thereof, a fee of £8.50 multiplied by the maximum number of persons for whom the applicant seeks permission to provide sleeping accommodation for reward.

Interpretation.

2. (1) In this Order, unless the context requires otherwise –

(a) “**the Law**” means the Tourist Law, 1948; and

(b) “**Department**” means the Commerce and Employment Department.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of this Order.

3. The Boarding Permit Fees Order, 2014 is repealed. ^d


Citation.
