The Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Guernsey)

THE HOME DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 5(1)(b), 7(3)(a) and 7(4)(b)(iii) of the Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Guernsey) Law, 2009^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Manner and place of fixed penalty payment.

1. (1) A fixed penalty must be paid –
 - (a) in cash,
 - (b) by postal order or by cheque made payable to the 'States of Guernsey', or
 - (c) by debit or credit card.

- (2) Payment must be –
- (a) delivered in person at, or sent by post (which in the case of a payment by cash, means by signed for delivery or special delivery) to, the Cashiers, Sir Charles Frossard House, La Charroterie, St Peter Port, Guernsey, GY1 1FH,
 - (b) made over the telephone by debit or credit card by telephoning the Cashiers at Sir Charles Frossard House, or
 - (c) made over the internet using the "Fixed Penalty Notice" section of the online payments portal of the States of Guernsey website (www.gov.gg).
- (3) A payment made by credit card is subject to the condition that a two per cent surcharge will be levied on the amount of the payment.

Revocation.

2. The Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Guernsey) Order, 2012^b is hereby revoked.

Interpretation.

3. (1) In this Order "**fixed penalty**" means a fixed penalty whose payment in accordance with the Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Guernsey) Law, 2009 discharges any liability to conviction of an offence particularised in a fixed penalty notice issued under section 2 of that Law.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of this Order.

(3) Any reference in this Order to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation and commencement.

4. This Order may be cited as the Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Guernsey) Order, 2015 and shall come into force on the 1st March, 2015.
